Four Chaplains Memorial Service: VFW Post 6709 in Waupun is planning to host a Memorial Service to remember and recognize the four United States Army Chaplains who gave their lives to save other civilian and military personnel as the troop ship, U.S.A.T. Dorchester, sank on February 3, 1943, during World War II. The ship sank after a torpedo from a German vessel hit it. The chaplains helped other soldiers board lifeboats and gave up their own life jackets when the supply ran out. The chaplains joined arms, said prayers, and sang hymns as they went down with the ship. The event will be held on Monday, February 4, 2019 at Waupun Area Junior/Senior High School in Waupun starting at 11AM. All veterans’ organizations and the general public will be invited to attend the program.
