**The Church Council suggestion for use of the \$390,000 gift to Pella** was passed at the Congregational Meeting last Monday evening.  
\$80,000 – LCMS South Wisconsin District Church Planting / Missions  
\$10,000 – LCMS Seminaries (\$5,000 each -Fort Wayne, IN & St. Louis, MO)  
\$200,000 – Pella Contingency Fund / Sanctuary Updates (Carpet, lighting in church, roof on Educational Building, North parking lot, etc.)  
\$50,000 – Church worker scholarship fund (\$3000 per year, beginning sophomore year in college)  
\$50,000 – Seminary Vicar (A Vicar can preach, make visits, assist in the office and Pastor Knuth would help train the person to be a pastor in the church setting. It’s a one-year commitment and the church would be responsible for wages, housing and insurance.)
